Is a tropical paradise located 14 miles from mainland Belize and right on top of the Belize Barrier Reef. It's a utopia of only 4-acres in size surrounded by a lush marine ecosystem. We have over 500 species of fish, 86 species of hard coral and so much more!

What will I be doing?

Spending 11 days on Tobacco Caye, you'll become experienced in surveying coral reefs, seagrass and mangroves while contributing to worldwide data collection on the health of marine ecosystems and be immersed in an environment perfect for studying marine biology and ecosystems!



What's included?

- Food – 3 meals a day provided by Windward Lodge
- Accommodation – bunk house style accommodation
- All lectures detailed in program itinerary
- Two night snorkels
- Wifi and plenty of hammocks!
- Access to marine station's resources
- All boat excursions around the South Water Caye Marine Reserve

- Participation and data collection in five projects all surrounding our local marine environment

Why Belize and the Barrier Reef?

The Belize Barrier Reef was designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996. It's part of the second largest barrier reef system in the world! Tobacco Caye is located within the South Water Caye Marine Reserve which is one of 18 marine protected areas.

Tobacco Caye is perfectly situated within close proximity to coral reefs, seagrass and mangrove habitats.
